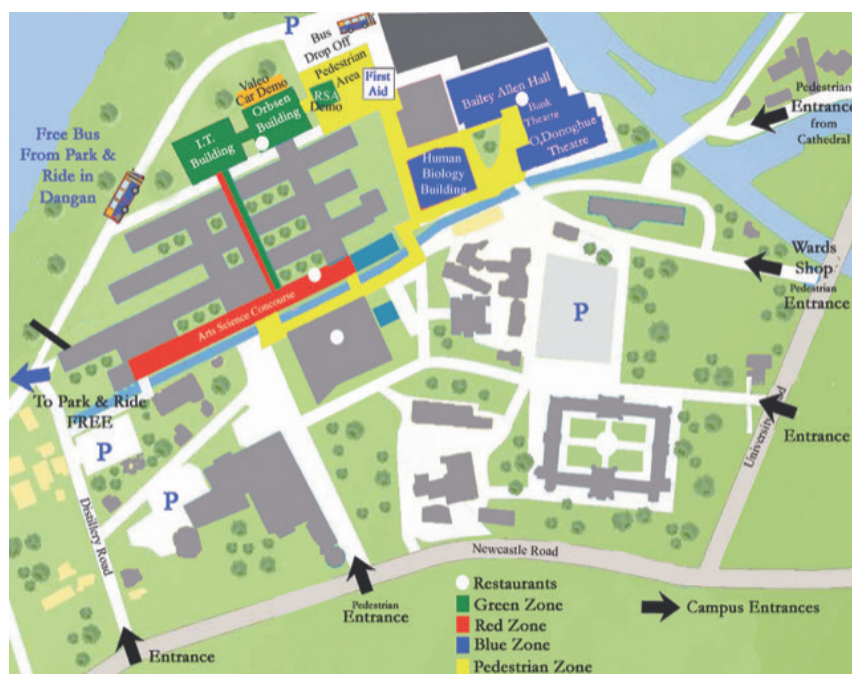

Tickets for shows and workshops

This is a free event. 70% of tickets for shows and workshops are released and 30% are retained for people to queue up for on the day. People with tickets are asked to attend 10 mins prior to the time to guarantee your place.

Park & Ride and take the Shuttle Bus

It is strongly advised to park at the Corrib Village (on the N59 Clifden Road) and avail of the Park & Ride service, running every 15 mins from 09.30am to the last bus at 6.30pm.

Sensor Room

A special sensory room is available all day in the Human Biology Building (Blue Zone) beside the Medtronic Experience, for that much needed time out.

Buggies

Due to health and safety buggies are not permitted in the main exhibition area of the Bailey Allen Hall, a supervised and secure buggy room is available at the Bank of Ireland theatre beside the O’Donoghue Centre in the Blue Zone.
